## **Project End Date vs Accounting End Date**

Internal Awards (IA; most commonly project I) and Research Investment Funds (RIF; most commonly project R) are set up in a similar manner as Sponsored Projects where this is a project end date and an accounting end date. The **Project End date is the last day for the period of performance**. The Accounting End Date is the cleanup period to allow for **posting of transactions that are within the period of performance** (i.e., between the Start Date and the End Date).





The "Setup KK for Project" tab shows the accounting end date


The "Project Reporting" tab shows the Project end date




