

# Virtual Permits in FY 23

License plates will be the new permits!



Physical hangtags will be a thing of the past.

# Updating Your Vehicle Information

---



- Since license plates will be the new permit, it is important for everyone to update their vehicle information in their myParking account.
- Update information in your myParking account in [AccessUH](#).
- To remove old vehicles you no longer own or use, email the information to [parking@uh.edu](mailto:parking@uh.edu).
- Vehicles with outstanding citations cannot be removed.



# Do You Have a Toll Tag on Your Vehicle?

---

- This is a hands-free way to enter and exit gated lots and parking garages. It costs nothing: No funds are deducted from your toll tag account.
- EZ Tag, NTTA Toll Tag (Dallas) or TxTag can be used.
- Equipment at the gates reads the tag and automatically raises the gate arm if the tag is associated with your permit.

# How to Add A Toll Tag to Your Parking Permit



If you'd like to use your toll tag, follow these steps to add it to your permit:

- Sign in to your myParking account through AccessUH.
- Click on your name in the upper right corner.
- Click "Manage Your Account Information" in the pull-down menu.
- Edit the toll tag information at the bottom of the page.
- Enter only the eight numerals in the toll tag number. Letters and special characters will prevent the tag from working properly.
- To delete an old toll tag, email the information to [parking@uh.edu](mailto:parking@uh.edu).



# Using Virtual Permits in Garages, Gated Lots

- Those who use their toll tag to get in and out will still be able to do so when we switch to virtual permits.
- For those who do not have a toll tag, there no longer will be a hangtag to swipe.
- Secondary options in lieu of a toll tag will be emailed to gated and garage permit holders.

# Garage Hopper

- If you buy a garage permit, you can pay an additional non-refundable \$100 fee to access other garages on campus.
- This does not include the Welcome Center Garages.
- Provides additional flexibility for students, faculty and staff.



# How Do You Buy Virtual Parking Permits?

- The process will be exactly the same!
- Only difference: You won't receive a hang tag!
- You won't have to wait for hang tag to arrive in the mail.  
No more lost permits!

# Introducing Virtual Meters

Virtual meters have replaced physical meters as the payment option for visitor parking spaces in lots on campus. This does not include the visitor parking areas within the garages.

- Text to pay technology
- Greater flexibility for visitor parking
- Visitor virtual meter spaces identified with orange coloring
