



Do you have a Spanish-English bilingual child 5-7 years old?

Dr. Anny Castilla-Earls, Associate Professor and researcher in the Department of Communication Disorders and Sciences at the University of Houston, is conducting a study to look at the development of language in Spanish-speaking bilingual children.

What is involved?

This is a 2-year study to look at children's language development over time.

- School year 2018-2019: 3 sessions of approximately 50 minutes
- School year 2019-2020: 2 sessions of approximately 50 minutes
- School year 2020-2021: 2 sessions of approximately 50 minutes

The activities will consist of storytelling games, pointing to pictures, and computer memory games. These activities can take place in our research lab at University of Houston or in your home.

What will we get?

Families involved in the study will receive a Walmart gift card for each session they participate in (\$10 per session, plus \$10 for transportation cost per session administered in the lab at the University of Houston).

Parents will receive the results of the hearing and cognitive screening and the results of the bilingual testing.
