

Certificate in Quantitative Economics Requirements

A Certificate in Quantitative Economics is available to students who complement their Economics major by completing certain quantitative skill courses.

A departmental certificate will be issued once completed.

It is not a declared item and will not appear on your transcript. But you can (and should!) add it to your resume.

To earn a certificate, the student must earn a ***B or better*** in the following courses:

Econ 3370 - Introduction to Econometrics

And **two** out of the following courses:

1. Econ 4338 - Regression Causal Modeling and Social Science Data Mining
2. Econ 4395 – Applied Econometrics
3. Econ 3362 – Mathematics for Economics
4. Econ 3357 – Data Management with Economic Applications

Submit the Certificate Application to the undergraduate director, Dr. Natalia Zhivan, by the end of your last semester and your certificate will be mailed to you over summer or over the next semester.
