After NIH releases priority review scores, NIH sends an e-mail requesting Just-In-Time (JIT) information for grants within the competitive range for possible funding. This notification, sent to the PD/PI, is NOT a Notice of Award, nor should it be construed as an indicator of possible award. JIT information requested may include:

- Other support documents
- Certification of Institutional Review Board (IRB) approval
- Certification of Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) approval
- Human subjects training certification for all key personnel

JIT information must be submitted for NIH review and evaluation *prior* to making an award, This information must be *submitted via the Just-In-Time function within the eRA Commons* portal by the appropriate Authorized Organization Representative from your institution.
