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UH Transfer Rules

- Courses taken at HCC must be completed with a C- or better.
- A maximum of 66 lower-level transfer credits can be used towards a UH bachelor's degree.
- A maximum of 2 credit hours in physical activity courses can transfer.

Major Requirements

- **B.S. Math & Science:** complete 18 hours of core Mathematics; core Life & Physical Science courses; or non-core BCHS, BIOL, CHEM, COSC, GEOL, MATH, and PHYS courses.
- **Minor:** complete a minor or approved substitute. No more than 6 hours of major coursework can be used towards the minor.
- The CLASS Block and CLASS Peoples & Societies requirements are not required for the Sport Administration major.
- Complete KINE 1301 (UH KIN 1352), KIN 3305, KIN 3360, and KIN 4355 with a C- or better.
