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UH Transfer Rules

- Courses taken at WCJC must be completed with a C- or better.
- A maximum of 66 lower-level transfer credits can be used towards a UH bachelor's degree.
- A maximum of 2 credit hours in physical activity courses can transfer.

Major Requirements

- **B.S. Math & Science:** complete 18 hours of core Mathematics or Life & Physical Science courses. Students majoring in Human Nutrition & Foods – ACEND will fulfill these requirements through the major coursework.
- This major does not require a CLASS Peoples & Societies course, CLASS Block courses, or a minor.
- To qualify for the ACEND Accredited major, students must complete CHEM 1411, CHEM 1412, NUTR 3101, and at least 12 hours of didactic program in dietetics (DPD) coursework with a minimum 3.00 DPD GPA. A complete list of DPD coursework can be found in the UH undergraduate catalog.
