

UH Official Enrollment

- * Students are added into Blackboard when they officially enroll in **myUH (PeopleSoft)** for a course that uses Blackboard.
- * Enrollment in Blackboard normally occurs only on or after the first day of class.
- * Enrollment in Blackboard normally takes 24-48 hours after enrollment in myUH (PeopleSoft).
- * When a student is officially dropped from a course, the student is normally dropped from the course roster inside Blackboard within 24-48 hours.
- * If a student has officially dropped a course through the registration system add/drop process, for whatever reason, the student is no longer a member of the class even if the student has not yet been removed from the Blackboard portion of the course.
- * After an official drop has been processed, the ability to access Blackboard does

Logging In Assignments Courses Email and Messages

FAQ:

- How do I login? Login using your cougar ID and password. (from accessUH)
- Why can't I find a future assignment I saw on the syllabus? Professors control when you can access assignments.
- How do I check that my assignment was submitted? For each submission, you will get a confirmation number. This number can be found on the *Review Submission History* page that appears once you have submitted an assignment. There is also an email confirmation sent with the submission confirmation number.
- If I just enrolled in a class when will it appear on my blackboard account? Depending on if the course is available or not, it should appear within a few days. If it has not appeared after one 3 days contact your advisor.
