

## APPLICATION — The Online Graduate Certificate in Arts and Health

The Online Graduate Certificate in Arts and Health Program, offered through the **M.A. in Arts Leadership Program**, is an exclusive 9-credit, non-degree program at the University of Houston. The program will combine academic and professional training for students preparing to integrate the fine and performing arts into the areas of health, healthcare, and well-being. During this online synchronous program, students will have the opportunity to meet with their instructors and peers in each of their classes for a one-week in-person portion of the course. Students will have the option of engaging in field trips and visiting with working professionals in the field in the city of Houston.

### CERTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

#### For Current UH Graduate Students

- Must have completed a minimum of 9 graduate credit hours in a related field with a minimum GPA of 3.0.
- Related fields include (but are not limited to): art, art history, arts leadership, architecture, anthropology, education, history, health sciences, liberal arts, music, medicine, nursing, theatre, dance, social work, social sciences, sociology, world cultures, and literature.

#### For Prospective UH Graduate Students

- Must hold a graduate degree from an accredited institution and apply to the University of Houston, including paying the standard application fee.
- Once admitted to UH, must submit this completed application to [arld@central.uh.edu](mailto:arld@central.uh.edu) with the subject line: Arts & Health Online Graduate Certificate Application

- ARLD 6391: Internship Placement (with director's approval)

*\*It is highly recommended that students take **ARLD 6320** and **ARLD 6310** if not already completed in a previous degree or certificate track.*
