### **CALL & RESPONSE SERIES**

Visual artist Alex Julyan and composer Stephen Montague will be in residence at the University of Houston this fall to collaborate with students in the Moores School of Music and the Gerald D. Hines College of Architecture. Supported by the Cynthia Woods Mitchell Center for the Arts, Julyan and Montague will work alongside students to explore the interrelationship between architecture and music. Call and Response, a semester-long project, seeks to integrate auditory and visual space through the creation of a mixed-media installation which will serve as a living structure for sound. While Julyan works with architecture students to build a site-specific sculptural installation in the lobby of the architecture college, Montague will compose music in tandem to the construction process, inviting student musicians and composers to participate in a weekly concert series. The public is encouraged to visit the architecture lobby each week to experience the evolving installation through dynamic, collaborative performances, culminating in a final performance on November 24.


