

# 2020 SRC Poster Presentation Guidelines

- **Business casual dress code is required.** Dress as though you are speaking at a major conference (e.g. AAPG, SEG, etc)
- Posters dimensions and design
  - Maximum dimensions are 48" x 42"
  - NO SOLID COLOR BACKGROUNDS (uses too much ink)
- Poster Competition
  - Poster location will be emailed to you upon abstract acceptance
  - Posters should be placed at their assigned location on Thursday, April 23 between 4-6 pm. All posters must be placed by Friday morning at 9:00 am, April 24th to be eligible for the poster competition.
  - Please remain at your poster for the duration of the poster session (1 pm to 3:30 pm) – it is your responsibility to be present for judges
  - Judges are allocated 5 minutes at each poster so for best results you should be able to present your poster in less than 5 minutes.
  - An example judging form will be emailed to you once your poster has been accepted.
- Poster Printing
  - Email your poster as a PDF to Jay Krishnan ([jkrishnan@uh.edu](mailto:jkrishnan@uh.edu)) or Jason Ognosky ([jaognosky@uh.edu](mailto:jaognosky@uh.edu))
  - If your poster file is too large to email, upload your file here to <http://support.geosc.uh.edu/cgi-bin/upload.cgi> and ask Jay or Jason to print. Make sure to have your name on the file so they know which one is your poster file.
  - Print your poster a week to a few days early! Printing before Thursday, April 27th is highly recommended to avoid delays
