\*Placement in Theory & Aural Skills is determined by diagnostic examination. Students may be placed at any level in the sequence, including MUSI 1301 (remedial Music Theory). Students placed into MUSI 1301 must enroll in a summer trailer section of MUSI 1312 at UH, or graduation in four years is not an option. Please work with your academic advisor to determine how theory placement impacts your degree plan track.

\*\*Proficiency exam is a prerequisite for this course.

+ A passing grade on the piano proficiency examination is required for graduation. Piano/Organ majors must take 4 hours of class or private voice lessons in lieu of group piano courses, plus they must take MUED 3107: Basic Vocal Techniques in lieu of MUED 3108: Piano for Choral Conductors.
