\* Placement in Theory & Aural Skills is determined by diagnostic examination. Students may be placed at any level in the sequence, including MUSI 1301 (remedial Music Theory). Students placed into 1301 must enroll in a summer trailer section of MUSI 1312 at UH, or graduation in four years is not an option. Please work with your academic advisor to determine how theory placement impacts your degree plan track.

\*\* Proficiency exam is a prerequisite for this course. + A passing grade on the piano proficiency exam is required for graduation.

<sup>^</sup> Large ensemble for woodwind, brass, and percussion students must include at least two semesters of marching band. (String students are exempt).

Note: String majors must take both MUED 3104 and MUED 3105 String Methods I/II (MUED 3105 is taken in lieu of a 2nd semester of Brass Methods.)
