Requirements for Successful Completion of the GLOBE FLO

Global Leaders of Behavioral Health Education (GLOBE)

Eligibility Requirements

Students must meet the following eligibility requirements to apply to and be considered for the GLOBE FLO

- Be an MSW student entering Clinical Practicum 1
- Declare a clinical concentration and have strong interest in delivering clinical services in mental health and/or substance use disorder treatment
- Complete Clinical Practicum 1 and Clinical Practicum 2 by August following the academic year.
- Maintain a 3.5 graduate GPA (Advanced Standing students must have 3.0 undergraduate GPA.)
- Students can be in any enrollment model

Program Requirements

Students must complete all four of the following components for the FLO.

- Practicum Education Those who are selected as GLOBE participants will be required to do Clinical Practicums 1 and 2 at placements that deliver behavioral health services in an integrated setting.
- Course Requirements GLOBE participants are required to complete the course **SOCW**7378-Behavioral Health for Social Work Practice in Integrated Healthcare. The course is offered face to face in the spring and online in the summer.
- Training GLOBE participants are required to attend seven workshops per year.
- End-of-Year Skills Demonstration GLOBE Participants must successfully complete the End-of-Year Skills Demonstration, during which students will have the opportunity to practice the treatment modalities covered throughout the year, using a standardized patient.
