The PSR Specialist supports individuals with serious mental illness in developing, restoring, and improving functional skills necessary for independent living, community integration, and recovery. Services are delivered in accordance with the individual's Person-Centered Recovery Plan (PCRP) and Interdisciplinary Recovery Team (IRT) goals, and in compliance with all HCBS-AMH Medicaid requirements and Texas Health and Human Services Commission (HHSC) rules.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Provide face-to-face Psychosocial Rehabilitation services focused on skills development, including: - Social and interpersonal skills - Daily living and self-care skills - Community integration and use of natural supports - Coping skills, emotional regulation, and problem-solving - Medication self-management support (non-clinical) - Deliver services in community-based settings, including the individual's residence and other approved locations. - Follow approved service frequency, duration, and scope as authorized in the PCRP. - Utilize structured, evidence-informed interventions consistent with HCBS-AMH PSR service definitions. - Complete accurate, timely, and compliant documentation to support medical necessity and billing. - Maintain clear, objective, and behavior-focused progress notes in accordance with Medicaid and agency standards. - Coordinate and communicate with Recovery Managers, Nurses, and other IRT members. - Observe and report changes in functioning, behavior, or safety concerns per BECC policy. - Maintain professional boundaries and adhere to confidentiality and HIPAA requirements at all times
