The South Texas Veterans Health Care System offers a one-year paid interdisciplinary fellowship for social workers interested in the field of Palliative Care.

The Social Work Palliative Care Fellowship seeks to equip social workers with the knowledge and skills needed to meet the complex needs of patients and families facing life-limiting illness, end-of-life challenges, and/or grief. This is an interdisciplinary fellowship that provides focused learning alongside other health care disciplines. Fellowship experience also includes weekly education, interactive supervision, and direct practice with veterans and their loved ones.
