<b>Job Description</b>	<p><b>Postgraduate Fellowship in Clinical Social Work and Social Work Internship Program</b></p> <p>The fellowship and internship place a high priority on developing practitioners with a strong foundation in theory; a capacity to be reflective regarding their own values and use of self; and a capacity to assess the strengths and limitations of theoretical frameworks in the treatment process.</p> <p>Training occurs through course work, clinical practicum opportunities and intensive supervision. Trainees also focus on careful and thorough diagnosis and a compassionate, patient-centered approach to working with patients at The Menninger Clinic.</p> <p><b>Fellowship Opportunities</b></p> <p>Fellowships are available in Menninger's inpatient and outpatient programs.</p> <p>Fellows participate as members of interdisciplinary treatment teams and work directly with patients and their families. Fellows integrate diagnostic formulations into treatment planning, team collaboration, and clinical practice.</p> <p>Fellows conduct group, individual, and family therapy sessions and are involved in advanced case management. Combined individual therapy and family therapy caseload is typically 7-8 hours, with the distribution of family and individual cases varying depending on placement setting. Fellows are responsible for co-facilitating between 4-6 hours of group therapy, including process groups and psychoeducational groups.</p> <p>Each week fellows participate in approximately 10 hours of individual supervision, group supervision, and didactic seminars. Didactic seminar topics include family therapy, individual therapy case conference, group facilitation, psychodynamic psychotherapy, a support group, and a seminar with rotating topics presented by staff members in different areas of clinical specialty. Fellows also attend a psychodynamic psychotherapy seminar with a cohort of psychiatry residents at Baylor College of Medicine.</p>
<b>Qualifications</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Master's degree in Social Work (MSW, MSSW) from a graduate college or school of Social Work accredited by the Council of Social Work Education (CSWE)</li> <li>- Concentration in clinical social work; specific background working with individuals, families, or groups is helpful, as is familiarity with the DSM-5</li> <li>- LMSW from the Texas State Board of Social Work Examiners (TSBSWE before beginning the fellowship)</li> </ul>
