Job Description	Neurodiversity & Disability Affirming Therapy Ltd. is seeking a part-time fee-for-service therapist holding a Texas LMSW credential (or a candidate eligible for LMSW licensure) to provide telehealth psychotherapy services to adults across Texas. This role may be a good fit for early-career social workers completing supervised experience toward clinical licensure (LCSW) who are interested in working with neurodivergent adults and individuals living with chronic illness or disability. This position requires a minimum commitment of 20 clinical hours per week, with a 90-day ramp-up period to build your caseload to that level (referrals provided by the practice). Clinical supervision toward LCSW licensure is provided at no cost to you by a board-approved LCSW Supervisor (LCSW-S), arranged and paid for by the practice. Supervision hours are paid time: you are compensated for required supervision, not just for client sessions. Supervised clinical hours completed in this role may count toward the supervised experience required for LCSW licensure in Texas. The practice is led by Dr. Jessica Brooks, PhD, practice owner and licensed psychologist (TX, NY, CT, WI, IL), a former tenure-track professor of rehabilitation psychology with more than 15 years of experience as an educator and clinician.
Qualifications	● Provide individual psychotherapy via telehealth under clinical supervision ● Maintain timely and accurate clinical documentation ● Participate in required clinical supervision toward LCSW licensure (paid, provided by the practice) ● Coordinate care with other providers when appropriate ● Maintain ethical and professional standards of care ● Hold a Texas LMSW credential in good standing, or be eligible to apply for one through the Texas Behavioral Health Executive Council (BHEC) ● Have completed a master's degree in social work (MSW) from a CSWE-accredited program ● Be comfortable providing telehealth psychotherapy ● Have interest in working with neurodivergent individuals and people with chronic illness or disability

Salary/Hours	● \$50–\$58 per completed 53–60 minute session, with the higher rate earned as your weekly caseload grows ● Paid for late cancellations and no-shows whenever the client's cancellation fee is collected ● Clinical supervision toward LCSW fully paid for by the practice – many practices charge supervisees \$400+ per month for supervision; here it costs you nothing, and your supervision time is compensated ● At the minimum caseload of 20 sessions per week, that's approximately \$4,300 –\$5,000 per month; many clinicians build well beyond that ● Opportunity to grow into a fully licensed staff position upon LCSW licensure ● Flexible scheduling – set your own hours, including evenings or weekends, on your terms ● Referrals provided by the practice – no marketing or networking required to fill your caseload ● 100% remote: work from anywhere in Texas, no commute ● No non-compete agreement
