Job Description	<p>The Foster Care Adoption Treatment Director provides key leadership and collaboration in the ongoing development, integration, and training oversight of the treatment program, including clinical responsibility for managing therapeutic interventions and providing direction and leadership of the treatment program. The Treatment Director leads a multidisciplinary treatment team to inform and provide oversight to the development of individualized treatment plans for each child in care, ensuring appropriate therapeutic, educational, and medical services. The Treatment Director develops well-informed advice and strategies that are sensitive to the various needs of multiple stakeholders and partners and reflects the strategic direction of the organization. The Treatment Director also provides direct supervision and leadership to clinical and program staff, ensuring quality service delivery and the safety and well-being of youth in care.</p>
