This entry level team member works collaboratively with the Innovent team, as well as the Texas Oncology team.</p> <p><b>Key Responsibilities</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Provides information &amp; helps coordinate access to resources and services for patients, families, and/or caregivers, making appropriate referrals as needed.</li> <li>• Completes patient forms when necessary (i.e. patient disability forms, indigent drug program, etc.).</li> <li>• May administer psychosocial needs assessments, distress and depression screens to patients and families, and then forward the assessments needing evaluation to the appropriate, identified clinicians.</li> <li>• Acts as a patient/family advocate in negotiating the health care system.</li> <li>• Relays identified patient and family needs to medical team members.</li> <li>• Documents all tasks in EMR accurately, appropriately, and timely.</li> <li>• Develops and maintains working relationships with community agencies, health care organizations, and other providers to promote a broad base of support for patients and families.</li> </ul>
