Application Priority Deadline: Nov. 2, 2026

Award: \$1,000 per year, renewable up to four years

Transfer Excellence Scholarship

Application Deadline: Jan. 15 prior to the academic year
Must transfer to UH from an American institution to qualify for this scholarship

Award: \$1,000 - \$2,000 per year (\$500 or \$1,000 per term)
for transfer students admitted for fall semesters
