II. Major Requirements

Students in this degree program will choose from one of seven areas of concentrated study: Ancient Studies, Francophone Cultures Studies, German Studies, Global Cinema Studies, Italian Studies, Middle Eastern Studies, or Studies in Global Cultural Studies.

III. Bachelor of Arts Special Degree Requirements (6 hours)**

Six (6) hours of sophomore 2000-level Foreign Language in one language:

Six (6) hours of sophomore-level foreign-language courses: 2311 & 2312 in American Sign Language, Arabic, Chinese, French, German, Greek, Hindi, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Latin, Russian, Spanish, or Vietnamese

Bachelor of Arts students must have documented foreign language proficiency at the second semester of 2000-level or higher in one foreign language. *Satisfactory completion may require up to four (4) terms of sequential level coursework. Students with foreign language competency may satisfy part of or all of this requirement by placement or by credit by examination.

- *All tracks but Italian Studies and German Studies require UH-only WCL 2351 for core Language, Philosophy, and Culture.
- **The Italian Studies Track requires Italian; the Francophone Cultures Track requires French; the Middle Eastern Studies Track requires Arabic; the Ancient Studies Track requires Greek OR Latin; the German Studies Track requires German.
