INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Freshman

You'll apply as an international freshman student if you plan to attend the University of Houston:

- With citizenship from a country outside of the U.S.
- Have less than 15 credit hours from an accredited university
- Minimum 3.0 equivalent GPA (4.0 scale)
- Meet English Language Requirements

Transfer

Minimum 2.5 equivalent GPA (4.0 scale) in at least 15 transferable credits. If you've earned less than 15 hours of college-level credit, freshman admission criteria will need to be met.

Transfers from a U.S. college/university: meet U.S. transfer admission requirements.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

If you live in an English-speaking country that uses English as a native language, you do not need to meet this requirement. If you do not live in an English-speaking country that uses English as a native language, you must meet one of the following test score requirements.

TOEFL IBT: 79 | IELTS: 6.5 | Duolingo English Test: 105

TOEFL, IELTS and Duolingo English Test scores expire two full years after the test date.

- Send directly from the testing agency to UH.
- IELTS & Duolingo English Test Scores: The testing agency should send score reports to Undergraduate Admissions.

Cullen Leadership Scholarship	\$1,000 per year
