Send official test scores directly from the testing agency. Upload all academic secondary, high school and/or college or university records/transcripts to your student portal

4 Send I-20 documents
Admitted students are notified by email and provided instructions to receive an I-20

5 Attend orientation
Admitted students commit to UH by registering for orientation and enrolling in classes

INTERNATIONAL ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Freshman

Apply as an international freshman if you:

- Are not a U.S. citizen
- Have fewer than 15 college credit hours
- Meet the English language requirement

Transfer

You need 15 transferable credits and a 2.5 GPA. With fewer than 15 credits, apply as a freshman instead.

Transfers from a U.S. college/university: must meet U.S. transfer admission requirements.

UH accepts externally evaluated transcripts from WES, TEC and ECE.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

You must submit an English test score unless English is the native language of the country where you live. If you do not live in an English-speaking country that uses English as a native language, you must meet one of the following test score requirements.

TOEFL IBT: 4.0 | IELTS: 6.5 | Duolingo English Test: 105

TOEFL, IELTS and Duolingo English Test scores expire two full years after the test date.

HOW TO SEND TEST SCORES:

- Send directly from the testing agency to UH
- IELTS & Duolingo English Test Scores: The testing agency should send score reports to Undergraduate Admissions
- Use code 4236 to send ACT scores + code 6870 to send SAT + TOEFL scores

INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship	Award
Academic Excellence	Competitive merit scholarships; renewable Must submit application by Scholarship Priority Deadline
Tier One	Full tuition & fees up to 4 years + 2 years on-campus housing & meal plan + research/study abroad stipend eligibility Must submit admission application and Tier One Scholarship application by Scholarship Priority Deadline
Cullen Leadership Scholarship	\$1,000 per year; renewable No additional application is necessary. Recipients are selected by the Student Financial Support Committee from among the pool of admitted applicants.
