FRESHMAN ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Students receive automatic admission if they meet one of the following academic requirements. Eligible students must complete the University's application process to be considered.

1. Top 10%

High school students who rank in the top 10% of their graduating class are eligible for automatic admission to the University.

2. 3.5+ Core GPA**

Students with an unweighted Core GPA of 3.50 or higher in high school core courses are assured admissions at UH.

3. 1250+ SAT or 26+ ACT

Students have the option to apply with or without test scores. Applicants applying with a valid test score can achieve assured admission if they possess an SAT score of 1250 or higher or an ACT score of 26 or higher.

**If you don't meet the assured admissions requirements, we will use your Common App or ApplyTexas essay and your resume in our individual review process. All students regardless of how they apply need to submit an essay and resume.*

***GPA will be calculated based on English, math, science and social studies courses only.*

National Merit	Full tuition & fees each year + research/study abroad stipend eligibility
Cullen Leadership Scholarship	\$1,000 per year; renewable No additional application is necessary. Recipients are selected by the Student Financial Support Committee from among the pool of admitted applicants.

COUGAR PROMISE

Tuition and fees are covered for those with an adjusted gross family income up to \$65,000 who demonstrate financial need. Those between \$65,001 and \$125,000 receive tuition support.
