## Remove the holds below to register for courses:

- **Pre-Orientation:** This hold will be removed by completing the pre-orientation modules through your myUH account. ## Business

## Education

Within 3-5 business days of completing orientation, students will receive an email with instructions to complete a survey. Upon completion, students will be assigned an appointment with an advisor. ## Engineering

- **Attendance will be taken at the presentation.** Holds will be removed based on attendance.

- **Transfer Advising Session:** Advising will be handled by the departments.
- All students should be prepared to be available until 5 p.m. the day of their registered orientation.
- At the end of your advising session, you will then complete enrollment.

## Nursing
